【到達目標】

This course will provide students with the necessary tools to become adept in intercultural communication within the classroom and in our global society. Thus the following aptitudes will be developed:

(2) コミュニケーション能力

Students will learn how to build good interpersonal relationships and to communicate showing respect to others.

(4) 自己表現力・情報発信力

Students will gain the ability to respect and understand the opinions of others through disseminating new information from a cross-cultural perspective. This ability will be enhanced through group discussion and negotiation exercises.

(5) 異文化理解とグローバル人材力

Students will learn from exposure to a wide range of cultures to respect various values and gain correct understanding to work together with others in our global society.

【授業の概要】

This course will focus on Intercultural Communication from the formation of the field to the present day. The work of various scholars and their theoretical contributions will be introduced through class activities that will illustrate to the students the importance of being able to communicate cross-culturally. The class will be conducted entirely in English and students are expected to participate actively in class.

【授業内容】

第1回: Intercultural Communication—What is it and why do we need to study it?

第2回: Iceberg Model of Culture—Big “C” little “c” culture/Cultural self-awareness/other culture Awareness

第3回: Distinguishing Between Generalizations and Stereotypes

第4回: Sapir-Whorf Hypothesis—How we use language to say who we are

第5回: E. T. Hall—The Silent Language and the Importance of Nonverbal Communication

第6回: Finding Diversity in a Multicultural Japan

第7回: The D.I.E. Approach to Value Differences
(Description/Interpretation/Evaluation)

Students will be given feedback in class during activities to foster cross-cultural awareness. Written feedback will be given on all assignments throughout the semester.

第8回: Communication Styles and Their Importance to Cultural Awareness

第9回: High and Low Context Cultures and Communication Styles

第10回: Cultural Values as Expressed through Language

第11回: Hofstede’s Framework for Assessing Culture

第12回: Barna’s Stumbling Blocks in Intercultural Communication

第13回: Barnlund’s formula for interpersonal understanding

第14回: Ting-Toomey’s Theory of Face Negotiation

第15回: Bennett’s Development of Intercultural Sensitivity Theory
