【到達目標】

The purpose of this course is to provide students with an overview of the theories and practices related to global social policy. Students will have opportunities to write article reactions and a case study research paper, communicate through presentation, discussion and debate, and think critically about global policy issues.

【授業の概要】

Global Issues in Social Policy is a one-semester course offered to provide students with an introduction to the evolving transnational and global dimension of social policy.

Students in this course will learn about the construction and maintenance of the modern welfare state. The first part of the class builds the context through readings and discussions on global poverty and inequality, business, international trade and welfare. The second part of the class focuses on domains and issues such as labor, health, pensions and social security, education, criminal justice and population policies.

The course will focus on social policy issues in both developed and developing states to provide comparative perspective. The impact of globalization on poverty, equality, and employment will be considered. Finally, students will be provided with the analytical skills to determine the relative effectiveness of policies in specific national and international contexts.
