【到達目標】

- ① Grasping the flow of Japanese history through the basic knowledge of the main historical facts.
- ② Grasping the flow of Japanese history through the basic knowledge of the main historical facts.
- ③ Being able to understand the influence of the past on today's Japanese society.

【授業の概要】

The broad topic of this class will be “History of Japan: Japan and the World”. During this semester, we will talk about the history of Japan from Antiquity till 1905. This class will be intended for students who have no prior knowledge of Japanese history. We will try to help the foreign students to understand the historical background of today's Japanese society. Every week, after having read together a passage of a book, we will talk about the main historical facts of the weekly topic. A presentation about one of the topics addressed in class will be asked to the students. This class being the continuation of the first semester's class students who attended it to continue their attendance during the second semester. However, students who would not have attended the class during the first semester will be welcome.

【授業内容】

1. “Modern history in today's world” We will discuss about the importance of studying modern history today.
2. “Tradition and modernity?” We will try to examine why this opposition is so often raised concerning Japan.
3. “Japan at the dawn of the twentieth century” We will study the main characteristics of Japan at the beginning of the twentieth century.
4. “The breaking point of the Russo-Japanese War” We will examine the influence that the Russo-Japanese War had in the world.
5. “Taishō: World War I and democracy” We will examine the evolution in Japan during Taishō period.
6. “A deceived power” We will study the situation of Japan after World War I.
7. “The turn of Shōwa” We will see how Japan started to change at the dawn of Shōwa period.
8. “The Manchurian problem” The question of Manchuria from the end to the 1920s will be our topic.
9. “The Shōwa crisis” We will speak about the crisis that struck Japan in the 1930s.
10. “The road to the war” We will study the main events that pave the way to the Asia-Pacific War.
11. “Defeat and ashes” We will study the defeat of Japan and its consequences.
12. “A new era” The post-war period in Japan will be our topic this day.
13. “Japan and the Cold War” We will study the influence of the Cold War in Japan and the role she played.
14. “Japan as number one” We will examine the period that saw Japan becoming an economic giant from the 1970s.
15. “Japan in the twenty-first century” We will discuss about the situation of Japan in the new century.
